ORDINANCE No. 22

AN ORDINANCE OF UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CHANGING THE NAME OF BERNVILLE/SHARTLESVILLE ROAD TO WOLF CREEK ROAD; CHANGING THE NAME OF SHARTLESVILLE/CENTERPORT ROAD TO SHARTLESVILLE ROAD; CHANGING THE NAME OF PENN VALLEY ROAD TO VALLEY ROAD; AND CHANGING THE NAME OF MAIN STREET TO OLD ROUTE 22.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the Board of Supervisors of Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

WHEREAS, the County of Berks has established a countywide 911 emergency number to facilitate reporting of emergencies by the public, and to facilitate and coordinate response to crisis situations by local law enforcement, fire, and emergency medical personnel;

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate such emergency response, confusion as to the location of the crisis situation, which can lead to loss of precious time in emergency response and potentially lead to loss of life, must be prevented;

WHEREAS, the current names of certain streets located within the Township are likely to create such confusion; and,

WHEREAS, Berks County has recommended that the names of these streets be changed to names which will prevent such potentially life-threatening confusion.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above, the Supervisors of Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania do hereby change the names of the following roads as set forth herein:

Section 1. The following roads and streets will be re-designated as follows:


<u>Current Name</u>	<u>New Name</u>
Bernville/Shartlesville Road	Wolf Creek Road
Shartlesville/Centerport Road	Shartlesville Road
Penn Valley Road	Valley Road
Main Street	Old Route 22

Section 2. Any provision of any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date after enactment allowed by law.




