ORDINANCE No. 30

AN ORDINANCE OF UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 30 OF UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING STOP SIGNS ON SUNSET DRIVE, BOTH DIRECTIONS, WHERE SUNSET DRIVE INTERSECTS WITH PENN VALLEY ROAD AND SCHOOLHOUSE ROAD TO REFLECT THE CHANGE OF DESIGNATION OF THE ROAD KNOWN CURRENTLY AS "PENN VALLEY ROAD" TO "VALLEY ROAD"; BY AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 44 OF UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS FOR CERTAIN ROADS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP, TO REFLECT THE CHANGE OF DESIGNATION OF THE ROAD KNOWN AS "PENN VALLEY ROAD" TO "VALLEY ROAD"; BY AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 17-A -1978 OF UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, ESTABLISHING NO PARKING AREAS IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS, RESTRICTING PARKING IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS, AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF TO REFLECT THE CHANGE OF THE DESIGNATION OF THE ROAD KNOWN CURRENTLY AS "MAIN STREET" TO "OLD ROUTE 22"; BY AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 38 OF UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, RESTRICTING PARKING DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF THE SHARTLESVILLE FIRE COMPANY TO THOSE PERSONS VOLUNTEERING SERVICES FOR THE FIRE COMPANY, AND ESTABLISHING ONE HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE IN FRONT OF THE FIRE COMPANY TO REFLECT THE CHANGE OF THE DESIGNATION OF THE ROAD KNOWN CURRENTLY AS "MAIN STREET" TO "OLD ROUTE 22"; AND BY AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 40 OF UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, CREATING NO PARKING ON CERTAIN SECTIONS OF NORTH FIFTH STREET AND ON MAIN STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF SHARTLESVILLE, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA TO REFLECT THE CHANGE OF THE DESIGNATION OF THE ROAD KNOWN CURRENTLY AS "MAIN STREET" TO "OLD ROUTE 22".

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 30 of Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, establishing stop signs on Sunset Drive, is amended as follows:

Section 1. That two-way stop intersections are hereby established for vehicles traveling

on Sunset Drive in either direction at Sunset Drive's intersection with Valley Road and also with Schoolhouse Road.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 44 of Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, establishing a maximum speed of thirty-five miles per hour on certain roads within the Township is amended as follows:

Section 1. The following roadways shall have a maximum speed on the roadway of 35 miles per hour:

Feick Drive  
Forge Dam Road  
Industrial Drive  
Industrial Road Drive  
Jungle Road  
Kauffman Lane  
Lesher's Mill Road  
Mill Road  
Mill Hill Road  
Motel Drive  
Naftzigertown Road  
Northkill Road  
Old Bernville Road  
Peacock Road  
Valley Road  
Pheasant Drive  
Phillips Road  
Schoolhouse Road  
Skyline Drive  
Sunset Drive  
Winterhill Road

Section 3. Ordinance No. 17-A -1978, establishing no parking areas in certain locations, restricting parking in certain locations and penalties for violations thereof is amended as follows:

Section 2. That parking of any motor vehicle on the East side of North Fourth

Street, Shartlesville, Upper Bern Township, Pennsylvania, from Old Route 22 North to an unnamed alley which intersects with North Fourth Street shall be restricted to fifteen minutes for each vehicle.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 38, restricting parking directly in front of the Shartlesville Fire Company to those persons volunteering services for the fire company, and establishing one handicapped parking space in front of the fire company is amended as follows:

Section 1. That parking in front of the Shartlesville Fire Company on Old Route 22, Shartlesville, Berks County, Pennsylvania, shall be prohibited at all times by all motor vehicles except for members of the Shartlesville Fire Company who are actually performing services for the Fire Company at the time that the vehicle is parked.

Section 5. Ordinance No. 40, creating no parking on certain sections of North Fifth Street and on Main Street in the Village of Shartlesville, Berks County, Pennsylvania is amended as follows:

Section 1. That parking shall be prohibited on the west side of North Fifth Street between Apple Drive and Old Route 22.

Section 2. That parking will be prohibited on the east side of North Fifth Street from the corner of Old Route 22 for a distance of forty-five (45) feet toward Apple Drive.

Section 3. That parking will be prohibited on the northeast corner of Old Route 22 where it intersects with North Fifth Street for a distance of twenty-five (25) feet east of the intersection.


Section 6. All other provisions of the aforesaid Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 7. Any ordinance of Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania which is inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.


Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date after enactment allowed by law.


