

ORDINANCE NO. 66 2003

AN ORDINANCE FOR UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON MAIN STREET
IN THE VILLAGE OF SHARTLESVILLE, IN FRONT OF PREMISES KNOWN
AS THE SHARTLESVILLE HOTEL

Be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Upper Bern Township,
Berks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1:

That parking shall be prohibited at all times on that section of Main Street in the
Village of Shartlesville directly in front of the premises known as the Shartlesville Hotel;

SECTION 2:

That any person who parks a vehicle on Main Street, in front of the premises known
as the Shartlesville Hotel, shall be in violation of this ordinance and subject to the
maximum fines and penalties for summary offenses as determined by the Commonwealth
of Pennsylvania in effect at the time of the violation;

SECTION 3:

That any section of any Ordinance inconsistent with the terms and conditions of this
Ordinance are repealed to the extent of the inconsistency;
